#### Summary

Under the supervision of the Recreation Supervisor, the Art Instructor is responsible for planning and leading engaging and inclusive art programs, including one-day art classes and week-long summer art camps. The instructor should foster creativity, self-expression, and artistic skill development in participants while maintaining a fun and welcoming environment.

# **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Develop and lead interactive, age-appropriate art lessons for one-day classes and summer art camps.
- Maintain and promote excellent customer service relations with participants, parents, and staff.
- Encourage creativity and self-expression through various artistic mediums and techniques.
- Provide a structured yet flexible curriculum that meets the goals and expectations of the program.
- Prepare lesson plans and program descriptions in advance, making them available to the Recreation Supervisor as needed.
- Communicate with the Recreation Supervisor to request supplies and materials needed within the approved budget.
- Ensure an engaging and inspiring learning environment that is safe and inclusive.
- Attend all required training sessions and scheduled meetings.
- Respond promptly and professionally to any emergencies, complete necessary paperwork, and notify appropriate staff.
- Assist with the general maintenance and upkeep of the art room and supplies.
- Enforce Park District rules and guidelines in a professional and positive manner.
- Maintain a high level of concentration and attention to detail while instructing.
- Present a professional appearance and positive attitude while performing duties and representing the Park District.
- Perform other related duties and special projects as assigned.

#### Safety and Risk Management

- Maintains a working knowledge of all general agency and department-specific safety rules.
- Reports any work-related injuries to supervisor promptly.

- Attends required safety programs and in-service education meetings.
- Corrects unsafe conditions and/or reports them to supervisor.
- Uses proper material handling, equipment, or staff assistance when lifting and/or moving objects 50 pounds or heavier.
- Completes incident/accident report forms and promptly forwards them to the Recreation Supervisor.

## **Supervisory Responsibilities**

- May oversee a classroom assistant and/or volunteer while on duty.
- Ensure safe and proper use of all art materials and equipment.

## **Competencies**

The ideal candidate should demonstrate the following competencies:

- <u>Creativity & Instruction</u> Ability to teach various techniques while encouraging individual expression.
- <u>Safety Awareness</u> Follow safety procedures and ensure proper handling of art supplies and materials.
- Dependability Show up on time, complete tasks efficiently, and communicate effectively.
- <u>Planning & Organization</u> Plan and organize lesson content, materials, and program structure.
- <u>Professionalism</u> Maintain a positive attitude and treat others with respect.
- Problem Solving & Adaptability Address challenger and adjust lesson plans when necessary.
- Interpersonal Skills Communicate effectively with participants, parents, and colleagues.
- <u>Teamwork</u> Work collaboratively with staff to ensure a successful program.

## **Qualifications**

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Experience working with youth in an instructional setting required
- Prior experience in art instruction or camp setting preferred

## **Education and/or Experience**

- Background in fine arts, art education, or a related field preferred
- Previous experience teaching in a classroom or camp setting preferred

#### Language Skills

- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals.
- Ability to write routine reports, lesson plans, and correspondences and to speak effectively before groups of participants, parents, or employees of organization.

#### **Computer Skills**

## **Physical Demands**
