Mission

The Sycamore Park District strives to connect our community through wellness, nature, and recreation. We are committed to providing inclusive, accessible environments that foster connections among people of all abilities.

Vision

Our vision is to enhance the Sycamore community by ensuring our parks and facilities are welcoming and usable by everyone. We are dedicated to continuous improvements that prioritize accessibility, diversity, and inclusion for all individuals, regardless of physical or cognitive abilities.

Commitment to Accessibility

In accordance with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 12131), Sycamore Park District does not discriminate based on disability in its programs, services, and activities. We are committed to providing equal access to parks, facilities, and services. This commitment includes regularly assessing and improving the accessibility of public spaces and programs to meet the needs of our diverse community.

Current Accessibility Features

The Sycamore Park District has already implemented numerous accessible features across parks and facilities, including:

- Playgrounds with accessible surfaces (mulch or updated materials) at various parks like Boynton Park, Charley Laing Memorial Park, Founders Park, and more.
- Fishing Piers with accessible pathways at Sycamore Lake/Rotary Park.
- Shelters and Picnic Areas that feature accessible paths and spaces, such as those at Good Tymes Shelter in Citizens Memorial Sports Complex
- Accessible Sports Amenities, including bocce ball, disc golf, and volleyball at Citizens Memorial Park.
- Water-chair access to the splash pad at the Legacy Campus and Community Center.
- Wheelchair-accessible golf carts at Sycamore Golf Club.

Ongoing and Future Accessibility Improvements

Sycamore Park District is continuously evaluating parks and facilities to make them more accessible. Planned improvements include:

- Comprehensive playground assessments to improve accessibility to play features.
- Evaluations of trails and pathways to ensure easier access to park amenities such as ball fields, fishing areas, horseshoe pits, and bags games.

- Improvements to pathways and shelter access at Citizens Memorial Sports Complex including a level outdoor kitchen area with accessible counter heights.
- Updates to Sycamore Golf Club facilities to ensure accessibility in the clubhouse, caddy shack Grill, and pro shop areas.
- Future assessments for additional shelters, paths, and recreational spaces in parks like Merry Oaks Path, Riverside Soccer Complex, and Wetzel Park.

Partnerships and Community Input

Sycamore Park District partners with the KSRA (Kishwaukee Special Recreation Association) to ensure that programs, services, and events are inclusive for people of all abilities. Staff actively seek input from the community on accessibility improvements and are open to suggestions for enhancing our facilities.
